<u>Katie Beckett Program</u>—Allows children with long-term developmental disabilities, severe emotional disturbances, physical disabilities, or chronic medical illnesses living in the home to acquire a Wisconsin Medicaid card, regardless of income.

<u>Children's Community Options Program</u>—Provides support through different community services that are not available through other programs with the assistance of Community Options Care Managers. Services are offered to individuals with developmental and physical disabilities and severe emotional disturbances.

<u>Children's Long-Term Support Medicaid Waiver Programs</u>—Federal, state, and county-funded Medical Assistance waiver programs for children and youth under the age of 22 who have severe developmental or physical disabilities or severe emotional disturbances.
