Wisconsin is home to rich cultural traditions, and summer marks the heart of the powwow season. Below is a guide to upcoming traditional and contest powwows hosted by Native Nations across the state for June, July, August, and September 2026.

June 2026

- Dates: June 26 – June 28, 2026
- Location: St. Croix Casino, 777 US-8, Turtle Lake, WI 54889



July 2026

Red Cliff Band of Lake Superior Chippewa — [48th Annual Miskwaabikaang Pow Wow](#) (Contest)

- Dates: July 3 – July 5, 2026
- Location: Gaa-Miskwaabikaang Pow Wow Grounds, Red Cliff, WI 54814

Lac Courte Oreilles Band of Lake Superior Chippewa — 53rd Annual Honor The Earth Homecoming Celebration & Pow Wow (Traditional)

- Dates: July 17 – July 19, 2026
- Location: Honor the Earth Pow Wow Grounds, 8575 N Round Lake School Road, Hayward, WI 54813
- **Note:** This is one of the largest and longest-running traditional powwows in North America. The grounds are located directly on the reservation, right next to the Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe School.

August 2026

- Menominee Nation — Menominee Nation Pow Wow
 - Location: Scenic outdoor Woodland Bowl, Keshena, WI 54135
- Forest County Potawatomi — Meno Keno Ma Gē Wen Powwow
 - Location: Ka Kēw Sē Gathering Grounds, Wabeno, WI 54566
- Stockbridge-Munsee Community Band of Mohican Indians — 50th Annual Mohican Pow Wow
 - Location: Tribal Grounds, Bowler, WI 54416
- St. Croix Chippewa Indians — Annual Traditional Wild Rice Pow-Wow
 - Timing: Late August (typically)
 - Location: Tribal Grounds on Highway 77 (just west of Danbury, WI)
 - Details: Held to celebrate the annual wild rice harvest.

September 2026

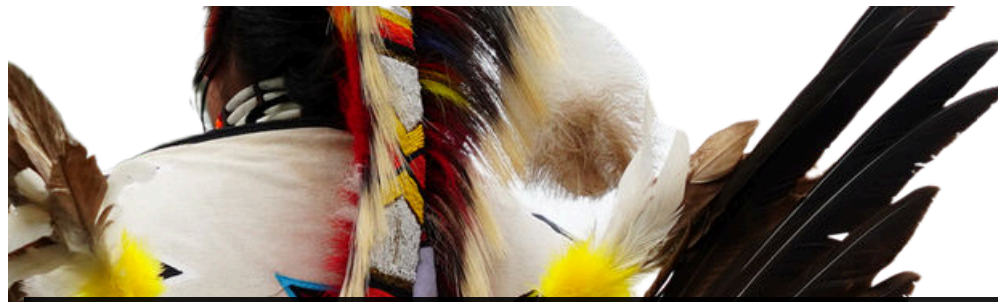
- Ho-Chunk Nation — Labor Day Pow Wow
 - Timing: Labor Day Weekend
 - Location: Andrew Blackhawk Pow Wow Grounds, Black River Falls, WI 54615
- Bad River Band of Lake Superior Chippewa — Manoomin (Wild Rice) Pow Wow
 - Location: Bad River Reservation, Odanah/Ashland area, WI

Powwows are sacred cultural and social events. While many are open to the public, visitors are asked to respect local protocols (such as listening to the Master of Ceremonies for when photography is permitted and standing for the Grand Entry).
